Butterflies

One of the target groups is butterflies. Over the past 40 years there has been a 76% decline in UK butterflies and many common species are now struggling for survival.

How we can help

Avoid pesticides and insecticides

Let your garden grow a little bit wild and plant some wildflowers

Butterflies overwinter as eggs so don't cut your garden back too much in the autumn and don't rake up the leaves

Weeds are just plants in the wrong place - don't rush to pull them up, butterflies and bees love them

How to take part - go out sometime between 18th July and 10th August and count how many butterflies you see. You can download a chart to help identify them:



Weedkiller Recipe

Sometimes you really do have to get rid of a troublesome weed. You can tackle persistent weeds without harming wildlife.

- 1 litre white vinegar
- 3 lrg tablespoon salt
- 3 teaspoons of eco washing up liquid

Dissolve the salt in the vinegar and then add the washing up liquid and put in a spray bottle.

bug hotel and a bird box. We've also planted a range of British wild flowers amongst the shrubs used for flower arrangements.




