This new and exciting course is designed to help equip those whom God is calling to lead people in worship, to preach the Word of God and to speak of the transforming love of Jesus Christ.

Our Presbytery Training and Development Committee and invited guest speakers seek to enable people to develop the understanding and to gain the skills required to lead worship in the Church of Scotland.

Enrolment:

Those wishing to attend this course should have discerned the Call to be a Worship Leader and also be nominated by their Minister and Kirk Session.

Attendees should complete the application form and they should also be available to attend all sessions on Thursday evenings 7-8pm. The online course is one hour per fortnight with some further reading. Attendees should also have the support of their Minister and a mentor within their own congregation who would provide accurate feedback and encouragement for the journey.

On successful completion of the course, attendees should lead an entire church service where at least two people from Presbytery will provide an assessment. A certificate will be provided allowing the successful attendees to lead worship in any of the churches within our Presbytery.
